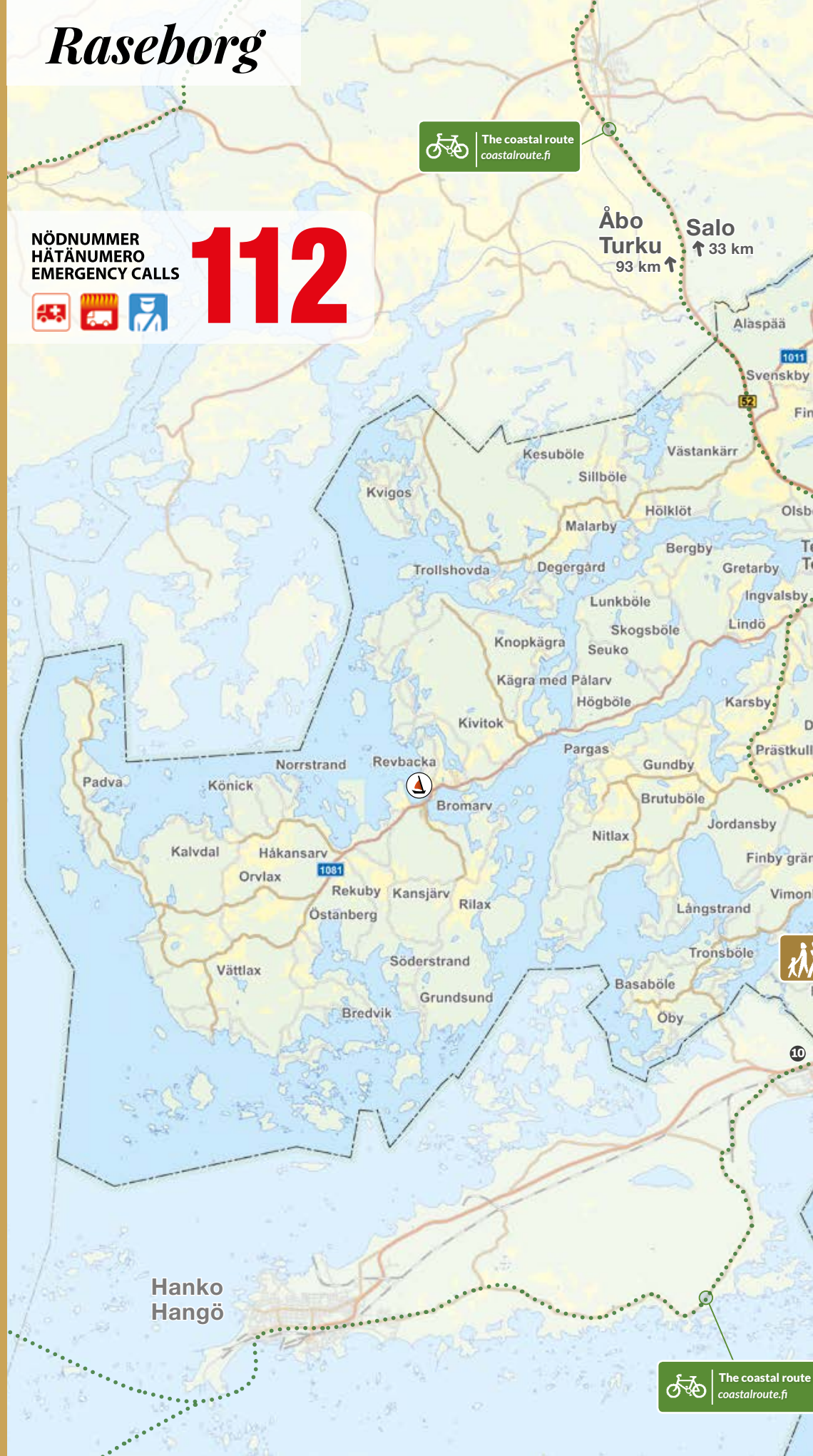

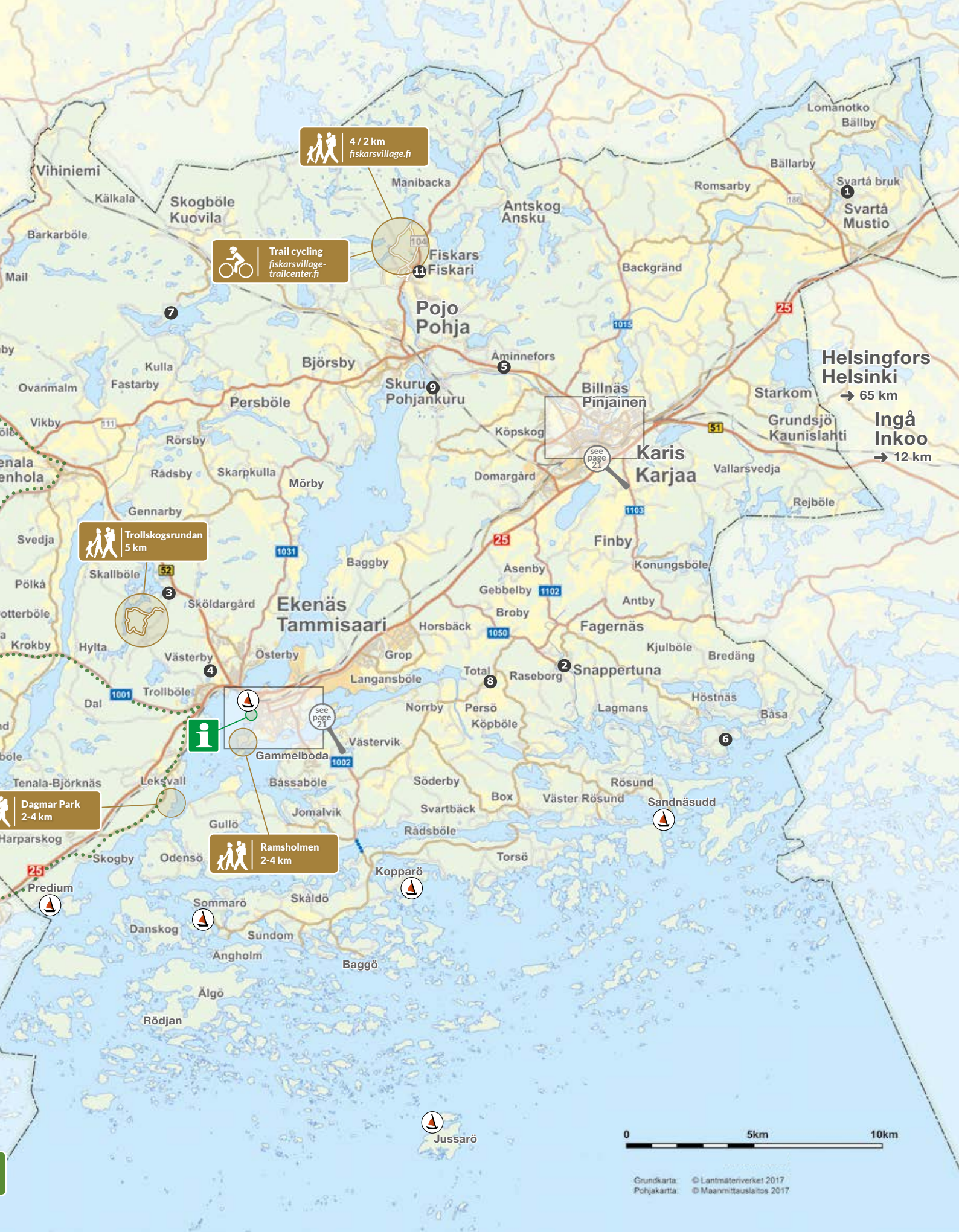

Facts about Raseborg

Located in the region of Uusimaa and founded on January 1st 2009 by combining the towns of Ekenäs, Karis and Pojo.

About **76 km west of Helsinki** (to Karis), about **111 km southeast of Turku** (to Ekenäs).

Area: 2,178 square kilometres, of which water comprises 1,035 square kilometers.

Population: about 28,000

Raseborg is a bilingual municipality where about 65% speak Swedish as their first language, 31% Finnish and a small group of other languages. Therefore, many neighbourhoods and villages have both a Swedish and a Finnish name (see table).

Raseborg is known for its many fine villas – among them Billnäs, Bromarv, Fiskars, Snappertuna, Svartå and Tenala.

The region is home to about **6,400 summer cottages**, a **unique archipelago** of about 1,300 islands, and Ekenäs Archipelago National Park.

When the municipality of Raseborg was founded in 2009 it was named after the historic Raseborg castle, dating from the 1300s. Today, the castle ruins stand on a hill by a river, but there were times when it was surrounded by sea. Throughout history, Swedes, Danes and pirates fought for dominion over the castle. But the ancient tales do not end there. History lives on in mills and smithies, castles, villages, museums, monuments and a vibrant cultural landscape.

Historical Fiskars. It is not a coincidence that the beautiful village of Fiskars was named Finland's best travel destination in 2015. The scenic ironworks settlement offers year-round experiences for all ages: Culture and design, crafts, a museum and high-quality exhibitions. The idyllic seaside town of Ekenäs was founded in 1546, at about the same time as Finland's capital, Helsinki. Discover the old handicraft quarters in the picturesque old town, and saunter along Finland's oldest pedestrian street, Kungsgatan. Also visit the EKTA museum centre, the Hagen- Ramsholmen nature park, and a versatile range of events. Enjoy the café culture, markets and cosy small town atmosphere. visitraseborg.com - Experience - Historical sights & museums.



The sympathetically-restored Svartå Manor is the largest non-church wooden building in Finland. The style of the building represents the transition from Rococo to Neoclassicism. We recommend a guided tour of the manor, a walk in the wonderful park grounds, and a meal in the excellent Slottskrogen restaurant. You can also spend a night in the manor house and enjoy breakfast in this beautiful setting. svartaslott.fi



The stunning Raseborg castle ruins close to the village of Snappertuna and its beautiful church. Grab a bite to eat in the Slottsknekens café - one of the country's first tourist amenities, dating from 1893. Take a guided tour around the castle, stroll on the lover's path and visit the museum. Summer events include an open-air theatre. utinaturen.fi/Raseborg



Billnäs is located in a beautiful area by the Svartå river and the old King's Road. The notable village has, like Fiskars, had a central role to play in the establishment of Finnish industry, and has been gradually restored. Visit Byggnadsapoteket ('The Building Pharmacy') and their impressive array of restoration and building supplies. Also, drop in to Billnäs Garden & Bistro in the middle of the historical village. probillnas.fi



The charcoal village of Malmbäcka demonstrates how charcoal used to be produced for the local ironworks. During the charcoal weekend in September old kilns are lit while activities and stories about them are shared - a nice experience for those interested in old working methods and traditions! You can book guided tours and accommodation in huts or simple log cabins all year round. malmbacka.fi

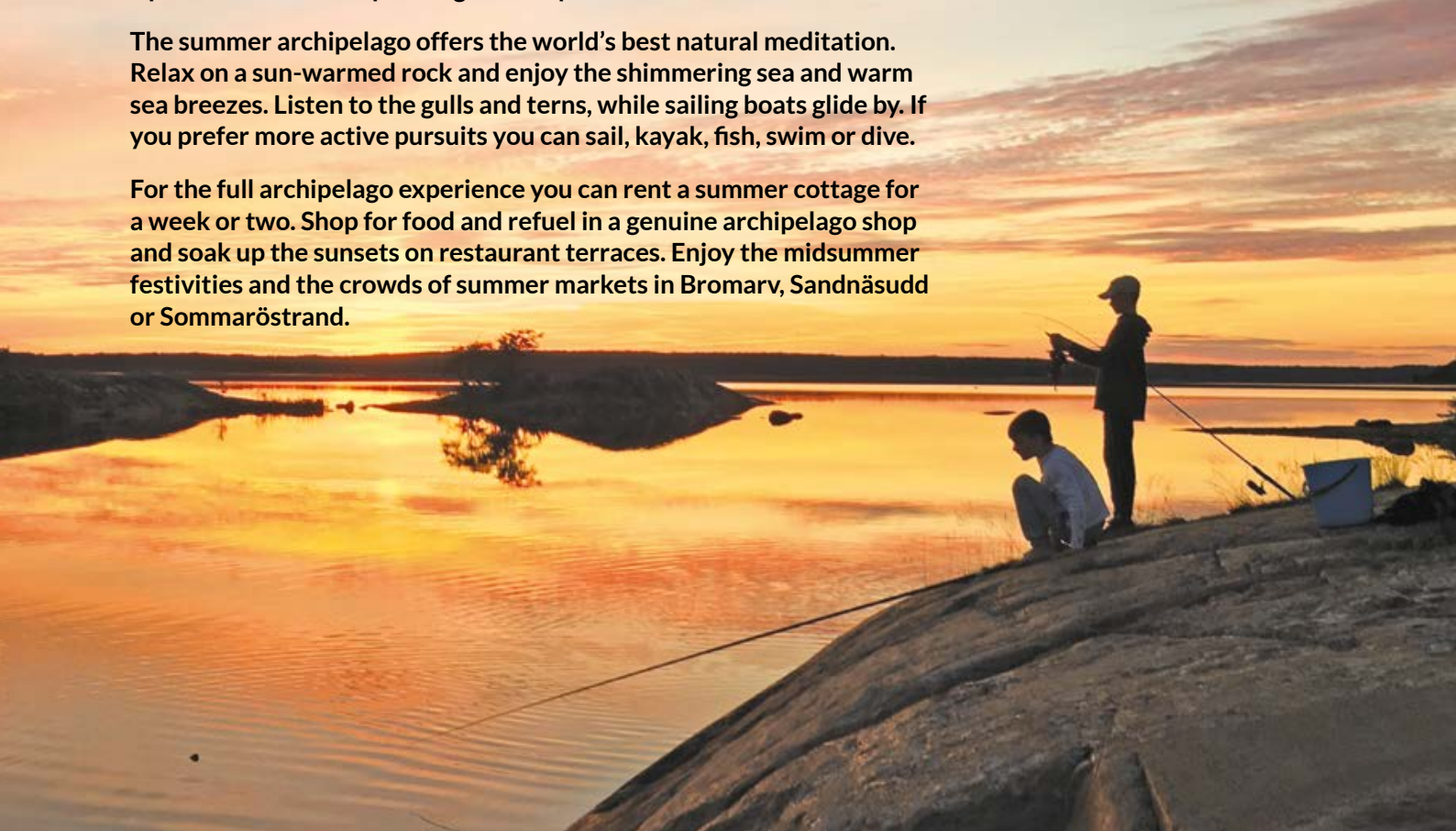

Seaside Raseborg

Raseborg's archipelago with about 1,300 islands is among the most beautiful in Finland. It offers a range of experiences, from the islands, sounds and bays of the inner archipelago to the open horizon of the outer belt. During cold winters the archipelago turns into a wonderland of snow and ice – perfect for long-distance skating, skiing on ice or a photo safari in the sparkling landscape.

The summer archipelago offers the world's best natural meditation. Relax on a sun-warmed rock and enjoy the shimmering sea and warm sea breezes. Listen to the gulls and terns, while sailing boats glide by. If you prefer more active pursuits you can sail, kayak, fish, swim or dive.

For the full archipelago experience you can rent a summer cottage for a week or two. Shop for food and refuel in a genuine archipelago shop and soak up the sunsets on restaurant terraces. Enjoy the midsummer festivities and the crowds of summer markets in Bromarv, Sandnäsudd or Sommaröstrand.



TIP!

Enjoy our amazing natural landscapes by bike - travel the coastal route, now also via Raseborg! The cycle route connects Finland's southernmost city, Hanko, with Kimitoön island in Southern Finland thanks to a new summer boat connection with the M/S Norrskär a couple of times a week. You could start the day before in Ekenäs, ride to Hanko, overnight there and take the morning boat to Kasnäs on Kimitoön island (and Örö if you want). Head back to Hanko and Ekenäs or continue from Kasnäs to Teijo in the Salo region. Return to Ekenäs with a detour through the village of Tenala, where you can rest at the charming Frimans Diversehandel-shop. If you want to see more of the southern coast of Finland, you can start in Helsinki and ride first to Raseborg Castle in Snappertuna, and continue to Ekenäs and Hanko. Remember to check M/S Norrskär's timetable in advance, it only runs in the summertime and on certain days! Read more at coastalroute.fi

In the Raseborg archipelago and Ekenäs National Park there are beautiful routes and fine natural harbours at, for example, Modermagan and Fladalandet. Consider a cruise to the ancient fishing settlement of Rödjan or the former mining island Jussarö.

If you want to stay closer to civilization or need to stock up on petrol or supplies there are many marinas that offer a variety of services. Perhaps the most delightful atmosphere can be found in the colourful summer markets of the archipelago villages and towns, such as Bromarv, Sommaröstrand, Sandnäsudd and Ekenäs.

Stressed? Tired? In a bad mood? Enjoy some time in the nature of Raseborg and ease your troubles! Embark on an adventure to the great outdoors. Choose a nice trail to wander along. Take a break and inhale the scents of nature. Appreciate the clean, fresh air and silence. Pick blueberries for a snack. Fish in a lake, take a swim and sleep under a lean-to. Wake to the sound of birdsong, prepare a cup of coffee and sit on a beach in contemplation. That's what we call true quality of life.

TIP!

Visit the beautiful Dagmar Park, about 10 km southwest of Ekenäs! The park comprises about 40 hectares of protected nature, given to the country by Fiskars in recognition of Finland's centenary celebrations in 2017. Enjoy the fairy-tale forests, rocks and sandy beaches. Take an empty bottle with you and taste the crystal-clear water produced by the spring at Källviken. The well-signposted trails lead to historically interesting locations. The park is accessible all year round, and partly suitable for wheelchairs and prams. Address: Leksvällsvägen 300, 10660 Ekenäs. Everyman's rights in a nutshell

YOU CAN

- move freely on foot, by bicycle or on skis
- camp or stay overnight on a temporary basis in a tent, vehicle or boat. Always ask for permission if you intend to stay close to private gardens, yards or cultivated property
- fish in open water or on ice, pick wild berries, mushrooms and flowers
- travel in waterways and on ice
- start a fire in clearly marked locations, such as a barbecuing spot. Ensure that the fire is fully extinguished before you leave

YOU CANNOT

- trespass on farms or otherwise cultivated land
- disturb or damage the environment through, for example, felling trees, or removing moss, lichen, soil or wood
- disturb wild animals or nesting birds
- start fires in unmarked locations
- litter or disturb the peace
- fish or hunt without permission
- drive motor-driven vehicles on private property without the permission of the landowner



The tastes of Raseborg

Raseborg is a paradise for lovers of quality locally-produced food. There is an exceptionally dense network of local food lovers, producers and organic farms. A number of farmers sell their products through farm shops, markets and harvest festivals.

In recent years Raseborg has also received a welcome influx of artisanal producers in the form of dairies, microbreweries, bakeries and even a distillery. 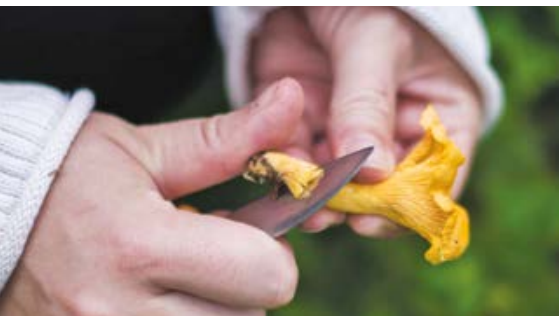

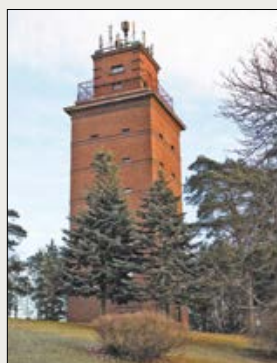

Old water tower in Ekenäs

Not recommended for those with a fear of heights, the old water tower in Ekenäs requires a certain level of fitness to climb the 164 steps. The fantastic view at the top is worth it, however. The key to the tower can be collected from and returned to the Raseborg tourist office at the Town Hall Square. In the summer the office is open Mon-Fri 9-18 and Sat 10-14, and at other times of the year Mon-Fri 9-16.



Nature Trails

Do you have a spring in your step? Explore Raseborg's nature. For example, the Trollskogsrundan, the enchanted forest walk in Västerby near Ekenäs Port, is a child-friendly, approximately 5.5 km long walking trail through beautiful forest. The path is lined with various picnic areas and shelters where you can have a picnic or barbecue pick berries or maybe take a dip in a lake. Also visit Dagmar Park, which, being next to the sea, is a perfect place for swimming-loving rambles! How to find Raseborg

Raseborg can be reached by car, bus, train or boat. When you are on your way to us, remember **there is no bus or train station called Raseborg**. If you are looking for transport schedules on different web services or your GPS, please enter a specific town, for example *Karis*, *Ekenäs* or *Fiskars*. Some navigators may work better with Finnish names, for example *Karjaa* or *Tammisaari* instead of *Karis* and *Ekenäs*. Read more on visitraseborg.com – *Info*

HELSINKI-KARIS

Train: From Helsinki central railway station. Take the train heading towards Turku and alight at Karis about 55 minutes after departure.

Bus: Helsinki-Karis. Take the bus towards Ekenäs or Hanko. Alight at Karis. Travel time varies from about 1 hour 15 min to 2h depending on the service.

Car: Drive west along motorway 51 for about 74 km. Then turn onto route 25, towards Hanko, and you will find Karis after about 3 km. Travel time: 1 hour. Distance: 76.4 km.

HELSINKI-EKENÄS

Train: Take the train towards Turku from Helsinki and alight at Karis. Change to the local train heading to Hanko leaving from track 1. Alight at Ekenäs after 12 minutes.

Train and bus: Take the train first to Karis as above. If there is no train connection to Ekenäs there is normally a bus instead. Check the timetables for more information.

Bus: Helsinki-Ekenäs. Take the bus towards Ekenäs or Hanko. Travel time: 1hr 20min to 2h.

Car: Drive west along motorway 51 for about 74 km. Then turn right onto route 25, towards Hanko, and you will arrive in Ekenäs after about 16 km. Travel time: 1h 15min. Distance: 92.5 km.

TURKU-KARIS

Train: From Turku to Helsinki. Alight at Karis after about 1 hour.

Car: Take motorway Route 1 out of Turku and continue onto E18. Take exit 16 towards Muurla. Continue on route 1861 and then take a left onto 186. After about 26 km turn right on route 104 (Antskogvägen) and drive for about 3 km. Turn left onto Lönnhammarvägen and continue for about 14 km. Finally, turn left towards Karis. Travel time: 1hr 30min. Distance: 118 km.
